

Game: Mister Game Master Sir

Type of Game: Ridiculously noisy, indoor game (Great for rainy days at camp)

Supplies: None

Rules: One person is designated to be "Mister Game Master, Sir"

- All other players are his subjects

Mister Game Master Sir begins by giving the rules of the game (which are as follows):

Mister Game Master Sir is the ruler of all – this is not a democracy, it is a dictatorship

Mister Game Master Sir rules with an iron fist and whatever he says goes

The circle everyone sits in is called "The Vortex"

For no reason may anyone look outside the vortex

Players are to raise their hand and wait to be called on

For no reason may anyone speak without first being called on by Mister Game Master Sir

Once called on, players must always address Mister Game Master Sir as "Mister Game Master Sir" before speaking to him

Players may tatttle on other players for breaking any of the rules

When accusing other players of unspeakable acts of rule violations, they must never point

Pointing is very rude and is like punching someone in the face

Players must never gesture with their hand; this is like punching someone in the face 5 times

If players tattling break rules during their tattle, they may be tattled on as well

Each round starts by all players and Mister Game Master Sir putting on their hats

To put on your hat use both hands to place an imaginary top hat on your head

Then Mister Game Master, Sir chooses someone to be "it" and passes to them

They then pass to someone else, who becomes "it", and so forth and so on...

- *To pass left, pat your left thigh with your left hand*
- *To pass right, pat your right thigh with your right hand*
- *To pass multiple people left or right, pat your left or right thigh multiple times*
- *To pass across the vortex, put right hand on left shoulder and point with elbow at player*
- *To pass back to whom passed to you, put right hand in the crease of left elbow and pat yourself on the forehead with left hand*

Failure to follow any rules may result in tattling to Mister Game Master Sir

Mister Game Master Sir will then address the accused player and ask if they did this thing

The accused must address Mister Game Master Sir and come up with an elaborate story or lie as to how they didn't break a rule

If this lie appeases Mister Game Master Sir, he may choose to have mercy on the accused

Players must NEVER admit guilt because this would result in automatic points

Points or fractions of points are distributed by Mister Game Master Sir however he pleases

The first person to reach 3 points loses the game and must pay the penalty

The penalty is thought up and agreed upon by the whole group before the game starts

Notes: This game is for 4-10 people; if you have many more, it goes on too long...
