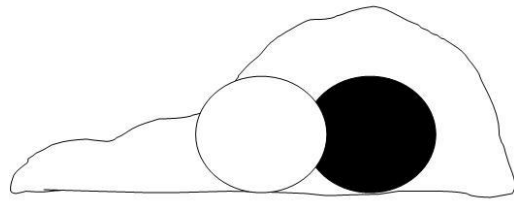


All Things New!

DAY #5 – LESSON PLAN – “A New Hope”

Bible Story – Luke 24:5-7, 46-47 and Mark 16:1-8 – The Resurrection of Jesus

Memory Verse – 2 Corinthians 5:17 *Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.*

- **Recap Days 1-4 Christ chose to suffer and die; no one had the power to compel Him**
 - This week we have learned how Jesus chose to die on the cross for our sins
 - Jesus is the Son of God and He lived a sinless life
 - He did not deserve to die
 - He chose to suffer and die to pay for our sins.
 - No one had the power to compel Him to die on the cross.
 - He died and was buried in a new tomb. And now it was the third day!
- **The Resurrection of Jesus**
 - At dawn on the first day of the week (Sunday) some women came to the tomb
 - Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome were their names
 - They had waited to come until after the Sabbath.
 - They brought with them more spices to put on the body
 - When they arrived at the tomb of Jesus, they found it EMPTY!
 - Jesus (the Risen Christ) appeared to Mary Magdalene
 - Jesus was alive!
- **Jesus Appears to Many People after His Resurrection**
 - After His resurrection, Jesus appeared to many people.
 - He appeared to the Disciples and to others
 - And at another time Jesus appeared to over 500 people at one time.
 - People knew now that He was alive again.
- **Repentance and Forgiveness will be Preached to All Nations in His Name**
 - Jesus reminded His Disciples of what the Scriptures said about Him.
 - *“So it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and that repentance for forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem.”* Luke 24:46-47
 - Jesus sent His Disciples out into the world to tell people about these things.
 - He told them they were witnesses of all the things that had happened.
 - And so, they told people, who believed and then told other people.
 - We are still telling people about these things today!
 - That is why we are here telling YOU about them!
 - We can all repent and have forgiveness of sins because of what Jesus has done!

Pray with the children thanking God that we can have forgiveness of sins through Jesus Christ. Amen.
